Description

ALEXCOAT FEM is two-component, Flexible epoxy material which combines Between adhesion and durability of epoxies with high flexibility.

Uses

- Designed for protection and coating on masonry substrates and building surfaces such as:-
Industrial areas.
Corridors.
Roof walls, Roof, Retaining walls.
Kitchens.
Food processing areas.

Surface preparation

The surface to be treated with ALEXCOAT FEM must be Clean and free from dust or loose material.

Concrete surfaces: All laitance must be removed by grit blasting.

Mixing:

- ALEX COAT FEM should be thoroughly stirred prior to application.
- Mix the component (B) to component (A) while mixing.
- Still mix till achieve a homogenous consistency.

Guide to application

Application:

ALEXCOAT FEM could be applied by brush lambs wool roller or by spray equipment.

Apply the first coat assuring a continues coating of uniform thickness and allow it to cure overnight, then apply the second coat till reaching the required thickness.

Coverage:

ALEXCOAT FEM is approximately Covers 10 m²/L @ 100 microns DFT

Storage:

Store out of direct sunlight, clear of the ground on pallets protected from rain fall.

Protect from extremes of temperatures.
